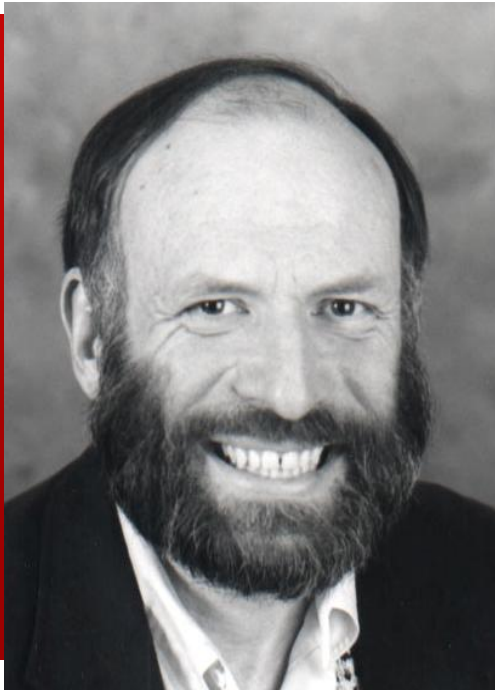

Ethics, Charles Sturt University, Australia

Larry May is a political philosopher who has worked on conceptual issues in collective and shared responsibility, as well as normative issues in international criminal law. He has also worked on professional ethics and the Just War tradition.

Professor May has a BS in international affairs from Georgetown University, and an MA and Ph.D. from the New School for Social Research, where he was Hannah Arendt’s last research assistant. He also has a JD in law from Washington University.
