### *Oceans and Coastal Protection: Law and Policy*

Our oceans and coasts are facing unprecedented pressure from habitat loss, overexploitation, pollution, disease, invasive species, and climate change. Dr. Elizabeth Kim, a scientist and attorney, will discuss EPA's role in protecting and preserving our oceans and coasts.

**Elizabeth Kim** works in the Oceans and Coastal Protection Division of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency in Washington, DC. She leads EPA's programs on cruise ship discharges and ocean dumping management. Dr. Kim holds a Ph.D. in marine ecology and a J.D., both from SUNY Buffalo. She is admitted to the Bars of New York State and the District of Columbia.
