



# APPLICATION CHECKLIST



## Baccalaureate Degree

Earn a **baccalaureate degree** in any major from an accredited institution. The degree must be conferred by the date of intended enrollment in law school.



## LSAC Account

Create an account with the **Law School Admissions Council (LSAC)** and sign up for **LSAC's Credential Assembly Service (CAS)**. The CAS service compiles your official transcript(s), recommendation letters, and LSAT Score(s) and Writing Sample.



## Standardized Test

Prepare for and take the **Law School Admission Test (LSAT)** or **Graduate Record Examination (GRE)**.



## Transcripts

Arrange for all **undergraduate and graduate transcripts** to be sent to LSAC. Request forms can be found on your LSAC.org account. Transcript requests will take a minimum of two weeks to process. Plan accordingly!



## Recommendation Letters

Arrange for **at least one recommendation letter** to be sent to LSAC. While one letter of recommendation will complete your file, you are strongly encouraged to acquire additional recommendations and may submit as many as four.



## Application & Fee

Submit the UB School of Law application, including your personal statement and resume, and application fee **online through LSAC**.
