#UBLawResponds Clinic Student Attorneys from the University at Buffalo School of Law have dedicated over one thousand hours since 2017 to providing service to communities and clients in Puerto Rico.



#UBLawResponds-Puerto Rico students enroll in four-credit course that begins in December, to get them ready to travel to the islands. In the beginning of January, our #UBLawResponds Student Attorneys study to prepare for the trip south while learning from local WNY and other experts, as well as Puerto Rican leaders, lawyers and community stakeholders. After their service-learning trip to Puerto Rico, each student produces a well-researched project to provide policy recommendations aimed at supporting Puerto Rico's power and resilience.
