# Tips on Safety Planning

- 1. Keep important numbers nearby.
- 2. Teach children how to call 911.
- 3. Let trusted friends, neighbors, and family know about the abuse.
- 4. Come up with a code word with friends and neighbors to let them know if you need help.
- 5. Try to get weapons out of the house.
- 6. Keep copies of important documents if possible.
- 7. Think of four places you could go to if you leave.
- 8. Practice how to leave safely.
- 9. Keep a bag of things you use everyday ready to go if you choose to leave.
- 10. Have a phone accessible at all times.
