<u>The Honorable Joel K. Asarch Elder Law and Special Needs Section Scholarship</u>
Value: \$3,500 Deadline: November 10, 2025

The scholarship is awarded to a second year (2L) or third year (3L) law student who is enrolled in a law school in the State of New York and is actively participating in an Elder Law Clinic at the school or performs other substantial efforts which demonstrate interest in the legal rights of the elderly or expresses an interest in helping the disabled.



<u>Elder Law and Special Needs Section T. David Stapleton Memorial Scholarship Value: \$3,500 Deadline: November 10, 2025</u>

The scholarship is awarded to a second year (2L) or third year (3L) law student who is enrolled in a law school in the State of New York who has demonstrated an interest in the Elder Law and Special Needs practice area and intends to practice in the field in Upstate New York following law school.



<u>Diversity Summer Fellowship in Health Law</u> Value: \$6,000 Deadline: December 5, 2025

<u>2026 LEWIS M. ROSE SCHOLARSHIP: One paid Summer Associate position with full-time Associate position offering Review of Applications: Rolling basis</u>

Kelly Drye & Warren LLP is currently accepting applications for this Scholarship which is open to all outstanding rising second year (2L) law students who are enrolled in an ABA-accredited law school scheduled to graduate in 2027. The Scholarship includes a paid summer associate position in their New York or New Jersey offices following the second year of law school. ABA Scholarships

<u>Diversity & Inclusion —SOGI LGBT Public Interest Scholarship Program Value: \$5,000 Deadline: April 15, 2025</u>

The Scholarship will provide financial support to a first, second or third year law student, or recent law graduate to enable the student or recent law graduate to work in the LGBT public interest arena for the Summer/Fall of 2021. One or more scholarships of up to \$5000 each will be awarded annually, subject to the availability of funds and the recommendation of the commission's Scholarship Committee.



<u>Intellectual Property — Foundation for Advancement of Diversity in IP Law Sydney B.</u> <u>Williams Scholarships</u>

Value: \$30,000 Deadline: December 15, 2024

The goal of the Sydney B. Williams scholarships is to increase the number of under-represented minority groups serving as intellectual property law practitioners in law firms and the intellectual property law departments in corporations. Since April 2002, the FADIPL has been awarding a number of \$10,000 Scholarships for Minority Scholars as well as arranging internships and mentorships to assist under-represented minority law school students intending to practice intellectual property law.
